

Title: Procedure for Obtaining EHS NOC for Construction Activities at Night

1.0 Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to describe and outline the method, how the client working on Dubai World Developments will apply & obtain EHS NOC for Construction Activities at Night (8 pm to 7 am).

2.0 Scope

This procedure will apply to the contractors involved in the Construction Activities at Night on all Dubai World Developments.

3.0 Procedure to be followed

3.1 All construction activities carried out at Night in areas under the jurisdiction of PCFC Environment, Health & Safety must take into account the requirements of EHS regulations and standards including the regulations for management of environmental nuisance from construction activities. In order to ensure that this is the case EHS NOC for Construction Activities at Night must be obtained.

The flow chart provides a step by step guide to ensure that all parties are familiar with the process and can make the necessary applications.

3.2 Application for EHS NOC must be made by the Main Contractor and / or Consultant. Application must be made after all measures have been taken at site but before starting any night activities.

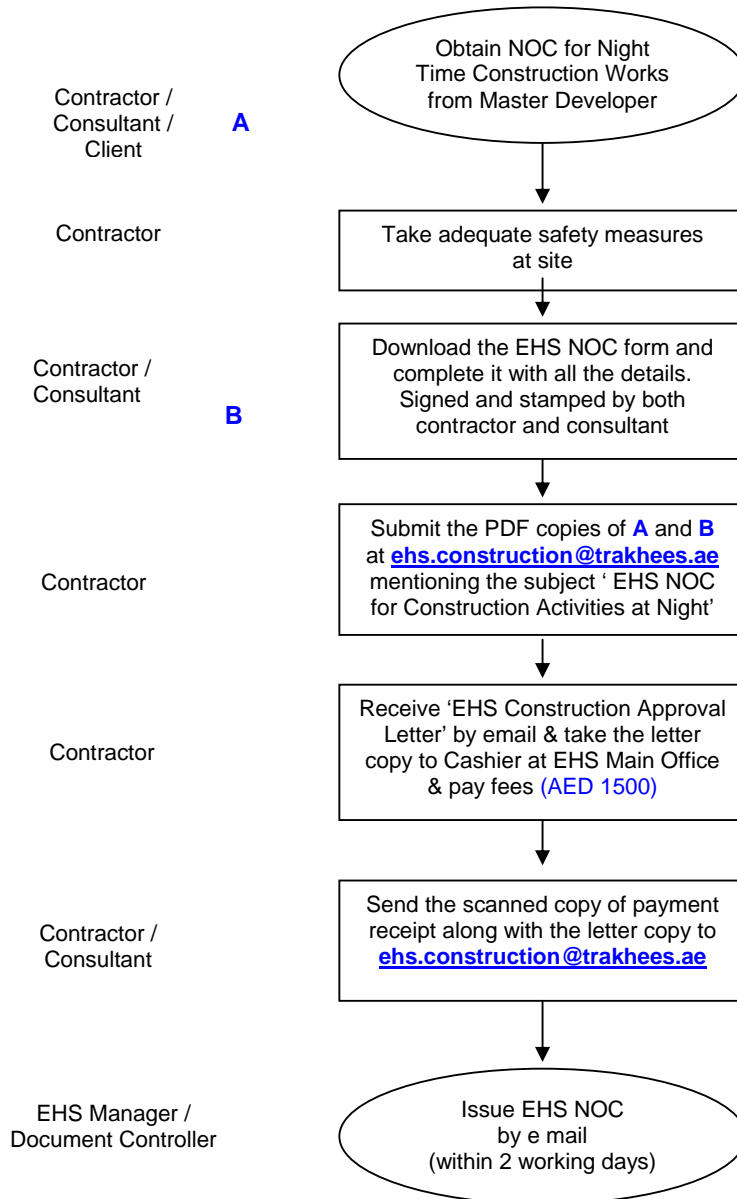
